OBJETIVOS:

En este bloque el alumno consolidará el material de los bloques anteriores y comenzará la transición de un Nivel Básico a un Nivel Intermedio. El contenido del curso sigue siendo funcional y se centra completamente en mejorar la independencia de los alumnos en todas las áreas.

En este bloque se introduce al alumno en los usos de los tiempos verbales del pasado, presente y futuro. Además, hay práctica frecuente de pronunciación, así como vocabulario general y práctica a nivel de oración. El uso de una variedad de ejercicios abarca diferentes estilos de aprendizaje, así como garantizar una cobertura exhaustiva de los temas cubiertos. El bloque se compone de una serie de ejercicios interactivos, como la asociación palabra-imagen, la comprensión auditiva con diálogos cortos y realistas y la práctica de escucha dirigida por el estudiante con los elementos de vocabulario.
